COVID-19 PLAN MONTECITO SEQUOIA LODGE FAMILY CAMP Sequoia National Forest, Ca.

The following safety measures have been put into place to limit the risk of coronavirus infections:

We ask all guests to contact us to reschedule or cancel their reservation if anyone in their family/group has exhibited COVID-19 symptoms within the 15 days prior to arrival, or has been in contact with someone who has symptoms and/or has tested positive for COVID-19 during that time.

Additionally, if anyone in your family/group experiences any Covid-19 symptoms during your stay, please report to our front desk immediately (with mask on) and ask to speak to the manager-on-duty for assistance.

Temperatures will be taken daily of all staff and guests. Anyone with a temperature will be immediately isolated and evaluated. Additionally, any staff member who is not feeling well is asked to stay home until they are cleared to return to work.

Staff and guests are encouraged to wash their hands frequently and/or use hand sanitizer frequently. Staff and guests are asked to use hand sanitizer when entering the main lodge and other common indoor areas.

Staff will wear masks at all times. Kitchen and housekeeping staff will wear masks and gloves at all times.

Guests will be required to wear masks inside all shared public buildings and for activities where appropriate.

Proper social distancing will be required at all times.

All normal main lodge activities have been moved outside for safety. Guided Activities will be offered based on Covid-safety protocols & staffing levels during the pandemic. No refunds if guided activities/kids' group activities are not offered during your stay due to the pandemic or other factors out of our control. Please note that even if guided activities cannot be offered during your stay, guests will still have access to touring the parks/forest and/or several onsite self-guided activities (such as hiking, sledding, boating, etc.) during the pandemic.

All meals will be served cafeteria style. We encourage guests to eat their meals in their rooms/cabins, which is still deemed safest by the CDC, or outside, when the State of CA and/or weather conditions allow. We have invested in added outdoor tables, chairs, dining gazebos & heat lamps to accommodate outdoor dining when possible, that have been spaced for proper social distancing. Please follow signage on dining tables regarding busing and sanitizing when eating out-of-doors, and please follow busing protocols after eating in-room as well. This will give our staff more time to do extra sanitizing.

As of March 17, 2021, Tulare County has moved into the CA Red Tier, which allows Montecito to offer indoor dining to our guests at 25% capacity. If you choose to dine at our indoor dining tables, please note that you may only share a table with members of your immediate household, and you must wear masks when not sitting down at the table to eat/drink. Please be considerate of your fellow guests by busing and vacating your dining table immediately after finishing your meal, so that other guests may dine after you (as we have limited indoor dining as set out by the CA State Safety Rules under the current tier). We also ask guests to please bring their dishes back to the busing area in the Dining Room when they are done eating in their room/cabin, or out-of-doors (when available), in addition to when using our indoor dining tables. Please dispose of waste properly by using the bear-proof and recycle bins throughout the property. Thank you!

Bathrooms, equipment, public facilities, handrails, and doorknobs/handles will be cleaned & sanitized on a regular schedule throughout the day. We ask that guests use the bathrooms in their own rooms whenever possible.

Please follow all posted social distancing and other signs pertaining to safe practices regarding Covid-19.

Please note: We will continue to update our protocols to reflect the latest State, County & CDC/Federal safety guidelines/rules regarding COVID-19.
